## Community Partners

CBT is always looking to establish relationships and partnerships with grade schools, high schools, and community locations that would like to work with CBT to initiate a tutoring program at a new location. To facilitate the development of these relationships, CBT board members are available to make onsite visits to discuss the organization and program process in greater detail.



The following is an example of the process CBT takes to develop a partnership at a school or community location. The process may differ depending on the location:

- Visit with your administration, or appropriate representative, to explain the organization and tutoring process in greater detail.
- Visit your location to meet with interested students, volunteers or other individuals.
- Send an information packet that contains flyers and brochures to be distributed to interested volunteers or participants.

The following is what CBT will provide to establish a tutoring program at your location:

- Handle all logistical issues involved in the development and continued oversight of a tutoring program, including recruiting tutors.
- Serve as a consultant to help you establish a unique and lasting tutoring program, specific to your location.
