CBT works to build and strengthen the diverse Chicago communities it serves through exposing young learners to the issues in their community. CBT's young learners not only grow academically but also play a role in giving back to their community.



CBT provides free, innovative tutoring services to youth within the communities of Chicago since its inception in 2004. At each of its sites, CBT serves Chicago Public School (CPS) students aged four to twelve with weekly tutoring services. CBT differentiates itself by emphasizing community awareness and civic engagement on the part of young learners, tutors, and volunteers. We strive to build up the diverse communities of Chicago by creating community leaders out of young learners.

CBT's efforts:

- It has offered free tutoring at 6 different Chicago locations since its inception
- Delivered over 5,000 hours of free tutoring
- Partnered with various community organizations to enhance our programming
- Hosted numerous community events and service activities to strengthen different Chicago communities
